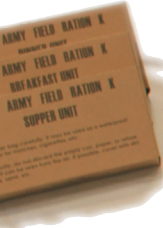
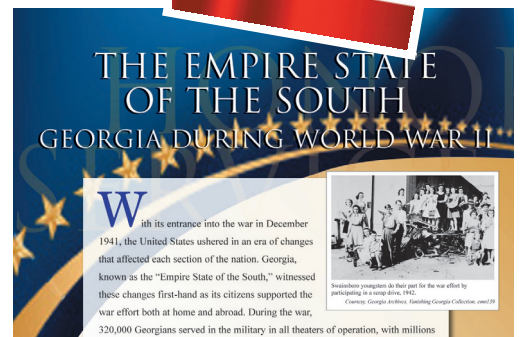
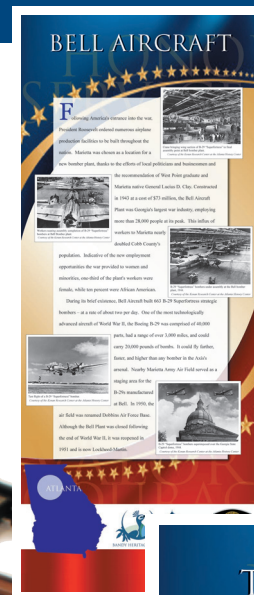


# Over Here & Over There

## Georgia & Georgians in WWII

- 18 Stand-Alone Panels
- Ship Models
- Tabletop Model of the Battle of the Bulge
- Four Interactive Footlockers
- Non-firing Weapons
- Designed as a Traveling Exhibit

The Bandy Heritage Center for Northwest Georgia, Dalton State College, and the Northeast Georgia History Center at Brenau University have prepared a traveling exhibit commemorating the contribution of Georgia and Georgians to the war effort in World War II. # ABOUT THE EXHIBIT

This traveling exhibition contains the following elements:

## (18) Stand-alone text and graphic panels

- each panel measures 80" H x 33" W = 50 running feet if placed side by side
- panels can be configured in a variety of ways to suit venue space
- topics for panels are in the accompanying materials



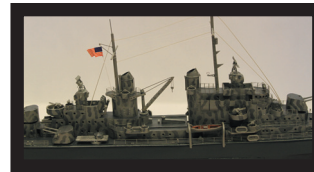
## (1) Model of the 6th Cavalry at the Battle of the Bulge

- model enclosed in a tabletop case with plex bonnet
- model measures 22" L x 22" W x 15" H
- model will need a pedestal or table for display
- model should be displayed so visitor can view from above or from eye level for optimum observance of detail



## (3) WWII ship models

- model of SS *James Oglethorpe*, measures 21" L x 7" W x 9" H on base
- model of the USS *Atlanta*, measures 25.75" L x 7" W x 9" H on base
- model of U-202 German U-boat, measures 41" L x 10" W x 12.5" H on base
- each model has a shipping bonnet, but will need to be enclosed in a proper museum case while on display



## (4) Footlockers with "dress-up" interactive items

- two footlockers represent military gear
- two footlockers represent home front items
- each footlocker measures 30" L x 16" W x 13" H and comes with wheels and a handle

Topics for these interactive stations include:

- Soldiers on the Battlefield
- Work Inside the Home
- Work Outside the Home
- Entertainment for Adults and Children
- Volunteer Service



## (4) Reproduction non-firing weapons

- weapons are attached by a cable system to a safety weight which will be installed by Bandy Center staff
- visitors will need a space at least 8 ft. in circumference to interact with weapons

Each station will need a table or area for visitors to sit and explore the contents.

Each station comes with a notebook of information about the contents.

The Entertainment for Adults section contains 1 CD player (CDs included) measuring 13" L x 8" W x 7.5" H and will need an electrical outlet.

- Map graphic – Georgia Military Installations and War Industries

## PRICING

This exhibition is designed so that each venue may take only the pieces it wishes to have, including the text panels. The desired time this exhibition should be displayed at each venue is 6 weeks. Pricing and exhibition period can be negotiated with the Bandy Heritage Center.

### Exhibit Rental Fee

- \$800 for entire exhibit for a 6-week period
- Individual pricing:
  - 8 basic text panels (required for all venues) \$300
  - Each set of (2) regional panels (5 regions total) \$50 each set of 2
  - Footlocker interactives (4) \$150
  - Reproduction non-firing weapons (4) \$100
  - 6th Cavalry model \$100
  - Ship models (3) \$150



*Total cost of individual elements is priced at a higher cost to off-set revenue lost from exhibit venues that cannot book the full exhibition.*

### Shipping & Installation

Each venue will be responsible for paying for shipping to its site. The Bandy Heritage Center staff will personally deliver and install this exhibit at each site. Each venue will be responsible for paying for truck rental, mileage, fuel, and travel expenses for 1-2 Bandy Center staff to deliver and install the exhibition on-site.

### Insurance

Venues will not be required to carry fine arts insurance for this exhibition; however, each venue will be responsible for replacement costs for any elements of the exhibition that sustain theft or damage at the venue during the exhibition period as outlined in the exhibition rental contract.
